

# Multi-table SQL

```
SELECT Airport.AirportName,  
Airport.Terminals, Country.Currency  
FROM Airport, Country  
WHERE Airport.Terminals > 2 AND  
Airport.CountryName = Country.CountryName  
ORDER BY Airport.AirportName ASC;
```

- Link the tables using the **foreign key** in the `WHERE`
- The **AND** is really important in the `WHERE`
- Use dot notation everytime you reference a field
