Where data privacy issues arise these should be considered.</p>	<p>Exam questions will be taken from the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • cyber security • mobile technologies • wireless networking • cloud storage • hacking (unauthorised access to a computer system) • wearable technologies • computer based implants • autonomous vehicles. <p>Students will be expected to understand and explain the general principles behind the issues rather than have detailed knowledge on specific issues.</p> <p>Students should be aware that ordinary citizens normally value their privacy and may not like it when governments or security services have too much access.</p> <p>Students should be aware that governments and security services often argue that they cannot keep their citizens safe from terrorism and other attacks unless they have access to private data.</p>
