

# WebPlus Colour Codes

In an exam you may have to set **specific colour codes** – for example, to use on buttons.

Colours will be given as **Hex Codes** – e.g. #2f2f4f. These represent the amount of red, green and blue in the colour – the first two numbers are red etc... This is a little tricky to do in WebPlus.

1. Click the **Swatches** tab at the top right to see blocks of colour rather than sliders. What we're going to do is add colours to the swatches available.

2. **Double click** the **Site Palette** button below the Swatches. This will open a large colour management dialogue box

3. At the top right of the new box click **Site Palette**. A list of colours appears

4. At the bottom of the colours click the **+** button to add a new colour to the palette

5. Type the **hex code** you need into the box at the bottom of the colours.

You can also set RGB colours here as well if you need to

6. Click **OK** and then **OK** again

7. Your new colour should have been added to the end of the Swatches box

You can now use the colour for text or for button colours – the colours in the Swatches box will be available when you edit buttons as well.
