

Smarts Leisure Park exam – the tricky bits

Other requirements:

Page template

– a banner which is the full width of the page and includes:

- suitable text
- the Smarts logo, linking to www.smartsleisurepark.co.uk

The banner must be a single image created in graphics software. A set of shapes and individual images is not good enough.
The logo (and only the logo) needs to be a **hot spot** to the web address

File formats

- images to be in .jpg format and less than 350 KB
- audio files to be in .mp3 format

This means that the two subpages should not be on the navigation bar but only linked from the Clubs Intro page (as thumbnails)
You need to edit the nav bar to do this

Thumbnails

– on the clubs introduction page, linking to Kidz Club and Teenz Club pages

Map of the park

– on the home page, edited to draw attention to some of the locations and/or activities featured in the microsite

This means you have to edit the park map in graphics software to draw attention to some places on it. Simple underlining, boxing or circling in Paint will do – but it's easy to miss an instruction like this in an exam

Shop products

– on the shop and café page, a graphical link that:

- shows any one of the products on sale
- links to an image showing a range of products available

This is the trickiest thing to do as it's got multiple stages,

First you need to read the text to find out what the shop sells

Then you need to edit the shop image to cut out one (and only one) product

Then you insert that on the page and make it a link to a **File** – which is the full image

Onion café menu

– on a suitable page

Contacts

– email links where appropriate

Audio introduction

– embedded on a suitable page, plays only on click

Clock

– a real-time clock on a suitable page, using the code in the file CODE.txt and the applet in the folder CLOCK

Ignore this. There are so many technical problems with inserting applets that the exam board is very unlikely to ask for it again!

This involves editing the images and should be one of the first jobs you do

Thumbnails are small images to buttons won't do.

You need to choose images to use and crop or resize them first, adding text to make navigation clear

Then these images need to be placed and used as hyperlinks to the two clubs pages

Make sure you add an e-mail link. You need to judge which pages to add them to.

Add sound from Insert > Media. You need to check how it will play
