

Italy Digital Poster Task

You have been asked to produce a sequence of Digital Posters to introduce Italy to Year 5 and 6 students.

You must produce **one** set of **four** digital posters.

The posters must:

- be suitable for use on a large screen
- follow the outline for areas that must stay the same
- introduce Italy
- be appropriate for the target audience
- run continuously in sequence on a screen

The posters must be fun to look at and include suitable images to help to get the message across.

1. Use a storyboard to **design** the posters. The **outline** (below) shows the areas that must be the same on all four posters and the area that must change.

Note: When the posters run in sequence, it should look as if only the central content is changing.

2. Ask for **feedback** from test users and make any necessary changes.
3. **Create** your digital posters. Check them carefully and make sure that each one is displayed for long enough to allow viewers to read it.
