

DVD Cover - Exporting

Once you're done, you need to export your final piece of work in two different formats.

Make sure to save your work as a Photoshop file one last time. You should have a set of different versions of the file, showing that you've used version control and effective file naming throughout.

First we need to export the work to send to the printer.

1. **File > Save As** > choose **TIFF** as the file type

TIFF files are high quality images which are suitable for commercial printing

2. Click **OK** > accept the settings on the dialogue window > **OK** on the pop up window

This saves your file for sending to the printer

Now, you need to save a version suitable for the web. This needs to be saved at 400 pixels wide (see the client brief)

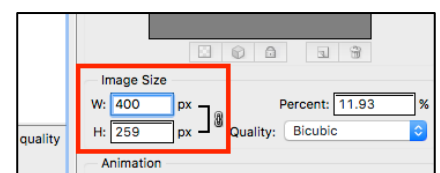
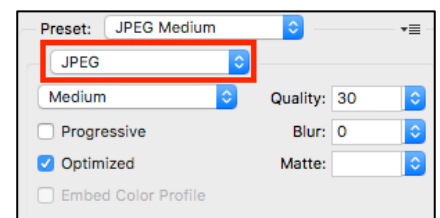
3. **File > Save for web**

4. Make sure **JPEG** is chosen at the **top**

5. Change the **width** of the image to **400 px (bottom right)**.

The height should automatically change

6. Click **Save** > choose where to save the file. Use a sensible name.



To check the resolution of the final image is right:

7. Open the jpg in Photoshop (**File > Open**)

8. Click **Image > Image size**

The width should be correct (400 pixels) and the Resolution should be 72 ppi
