WebPlus – Auto Loading a New Page

Sometimes you want a new page in a site to load after a certain time.

Make sure you're working on the page you want to show first

- 1. Insert > HTML Fragment
- Click once to drop the fragment on the page
 A code box will appear. Find the <! --Body--> area.

3. Replace the code in the <!--Body--> area with
meta http-equiv="refresh" content="20; url=nav.html">

- 20 is the number of seconds you want to move the page on after. You will need to change this value
- nav.html is the name of the page on my site I want to load. You will need
 to use the filename of the page you want to load. Right click and check
 Properties to find out the filename

Hint: if the filename is something like page2,html then you may want to change it to something more helpful

Make sure this is typed exactly right. Things like quote marks and semi-colons matter!

- 4. Click OK
- You can move or resize the fragment box. It doesn't matter where you put it – it will be hidden anyway.



When you publish your site you will need to test this code very carefully. It's tricky code to get to work. Ask if you need a hand.
