Graphic designer	Copy writer	Animator
Comes up with designs for products as part of pre-production – graphic designers are a key pre-production role Also create images and graphics as part of the production stage	Creates the text for adverts, web sites etc as part of the production stage . This can include the marketing of products and use of social media.	Plans and creates animations during the production stage . This could be traditional, hand drawn animation, stop-motion animation using models or computer animations
Photographer	Script writer	Content creator
Takes the photos required for a project as part of the production stage . May be involved in editing images as well as taking them	Writes and develops scripts for film, radio, TV, animations and computer games. Part of pre-production .	Creates content for websites, blogs and social media. May be involved in pre-production planning and in production stage creation
Web designer	Graphic artist/illustrator	
Creates ideas for what web sites will look like as part of pre-production	Create the images required for a product as part of the production stage
