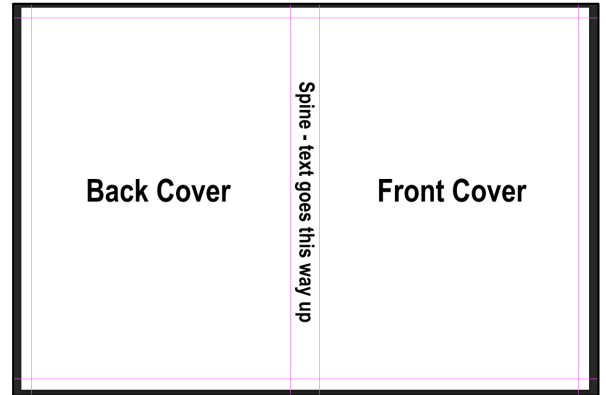


# Setting up a DVD/game cover

A DVD or game box front cover is usually 130mm wide and 184mm high. The back is the same size and the spine is 14mm wide. That gives a total width of 274mm (130 + 14 + 130).

1. **Open** Photoshop
2. **File > New**
3. Set the file to be **274mm wide** and **184 mm high**
4. Set the **Resolution** to **300 pixels per inch** – we're looking for a high quality image suitable for commercial printing
5. Click **Create**



This creates the base Photoshop document.

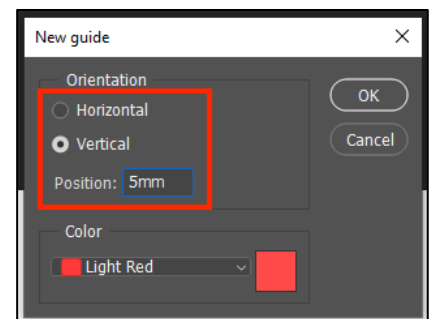
## Adding Guides

6. Click **View > New Guide**
7. Make sure **Vertical** is selected and enter **130mm**. **Don't forget the units.**
8. Click **OK**
9. **View > New Guide > Vertical 144mm**

That marks the right edge of the spine (130 + 14 = 144)

10. **View > New Guide > vertical 5mm**
11. **View > New Guide > vertical 269mm**
12. **View > New Guide > horizontal 5mm**
13. **View > New Guide > horizontal 179mm**

These add a set of "safety" guides around the edge of the template.



14. **View > Guides > Lock Guides** – this stops you accidentally moving the guides when you're creating the product
