



Cropping the image in PhotoPaint to get a square crop Using the crop tool Holding Control down to force the crop to be square

Adding and styling text Changing font, size and colour for impact








Image using three layers





Image resampled to change size to an approximate size I might use it at. I can reduce the size further in PowerPoint if necessary
