

Sorting and filtering spreadsheets

1. Open the **Olympic Medals** spreadsheet. These are from the 2024 Olympic Games which were held in Paris

This is a long spreadsheet. It has 93 rows

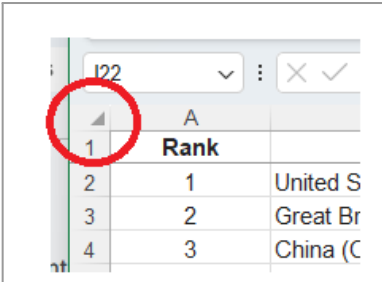
Sorting the spreadsheet

At the moment the sheet is sorted by number of gold medals. I want to sort it by total medals

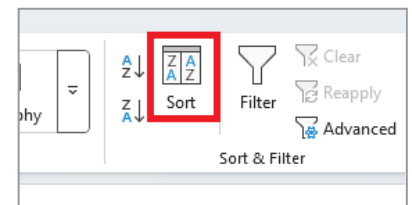
2. At the **top left corner** of the sheet, click the **small grey triangle** by the A column and 1 row

This highlights the whole sheet and is important to do before you sort

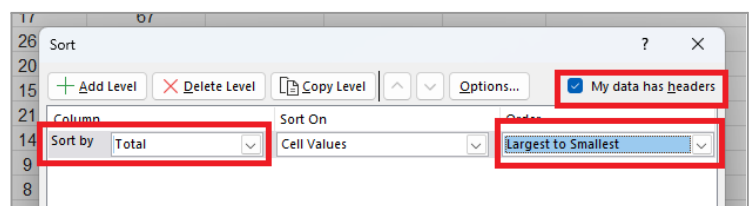
3. At the **top**, click **Data**
4. Click the **Sort** button

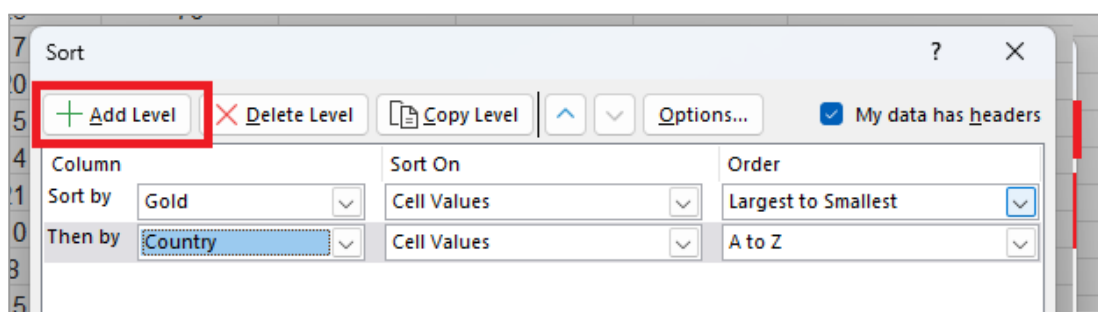


5. On the pop up window:
 - a. Tick **My data has headers**
 - b. Change the **Column** to **Sort by** to **Total**
 - c. Change the **Order** to **Largest to smallest**



- d. Click **OK** to sort the spreadsheet

6. Now sort the sheet by number of **bronze medals**
 - a. Click the grey triangle at the top left
 - b. **Data > Sort >** set up the sort to sort by number of Bronze medals
7. Now sort by **silver medals** but with the **smallest** number at the top
8. Now sort by **gold medals**, but add a second **Sort by** by using the **Add Level** button to add a second level sort as shown in the screenshot

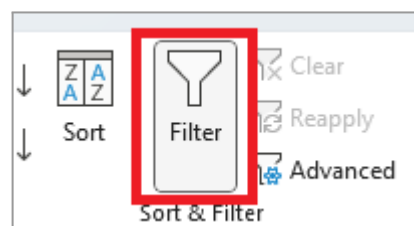


Filtering the spreadsheet

Sorting is OK, but it doesn't always help that much: there's still a lot of numbers there

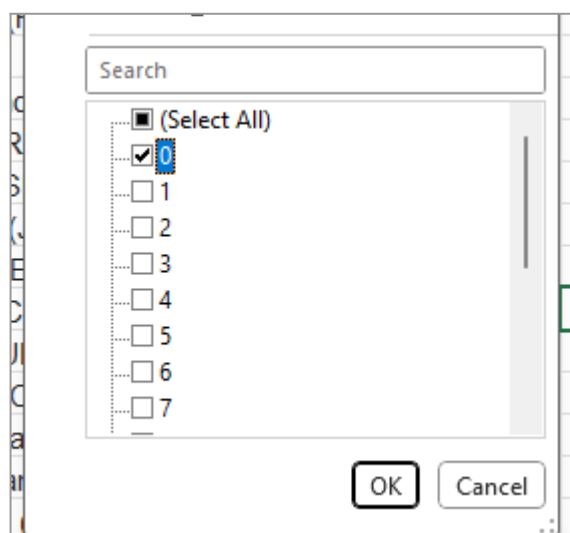
Filtering is another way of organising the data

1. At the top, click **Data**
2. Click the **Filter** button
3. Look at the top row of the sheet. There are small arrows by each of the column headers. These



are **filter arrows**

4. Click the **filter arrow** in the **Gold medals** cell (cell C1)
5. **IMPORTANT:** At the bottom, click the **Select all** box. This **removes** all the ticks
6. Now **just** tick the **0** box
7. Click **OK**



This will show you just the countries that got 0 gold medals (but that also got at least one other medal)

8. Go back into the filter and click the **Select all box** to put all the ticks back. This resets the filters
9. Use filters to produce lists of:
 - a. Countries that got exactly 0 bronze medals
 - b. Countries that got exactly 1 total medal
 - c. Countries that got exactly 1 total medal and that medal was gold (this requires two filters)

Don't forget the clear the filters each time
