

# Making an Animated GIF

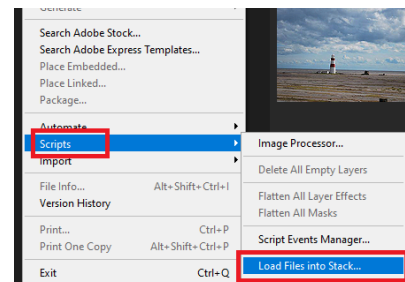
1. Open **Adobe Photoshop 2023**

## Load the images

2. At the **top**, click **File > Scripts** (toward the bottom) >

### Load files into stack

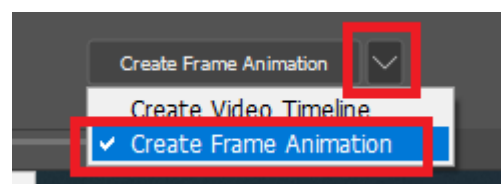
3. Press the **Browse** button
4. At the **bottom left**, click **On your computer** if needed



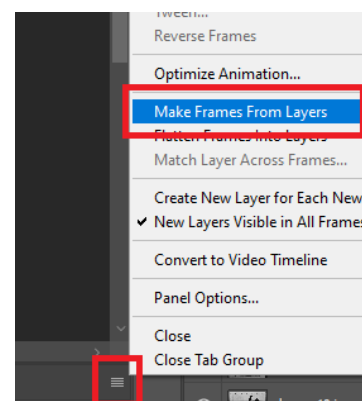
5. Get to your **OneDrive** and find the folder where your images are saved
6. **Select** all the images you want to include in the animated GIF  
**TIP:** hold **Ctrl** down on the keyboard and click on the images you want to use
7. Press **OK** > then **OK again**. It will take a little time to load all the images

## Create the Animation

8. At the **top**, click **Window > Timeline** (way down the list of options)
9. In the **Timeline** window, **press** the **arrow next to** where it says **Create Video Timeline**



10. **Change** it to **Create Frame Animation**
11. Then **click** the **Create Frame Animation** button
12. **TRICKY:** at the **top right** of the **Timeline Window** find the **three lines** (the hamburger menu). **Click** this and choose **Make Frames From Layers**



13. The GIF will run backwards  
Click the **hamburger menu** > choose **Reverse Frames** to solve this

## Export your GIF so you can use it

14. **IMPORTANT:** Click **File > Export > Save for web (legacy)**
15. Check it says **GIF** at the **top** of the window that appears
16. Click **Save** at the **bottom** > go to your **OneDrive** using the **dropdown at the top**
17. **Save** your GIF with a sensible name
