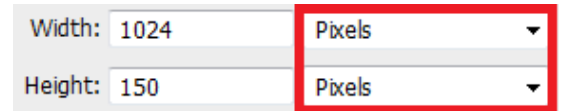


Making a Banner – Photoshop CS6

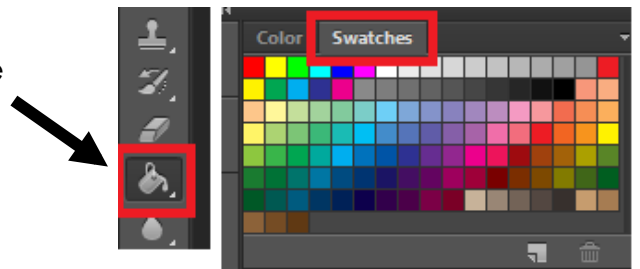
Step 1 - Set up:

1. Open **Photoshop CS6** – you'll find it in the **Adobe CS6 folder** in All programs
2. **File > New**
3. Change the units for width and height to **pixels**
4. Set the **width** and **height** (150 pixels high is fine) > **OK**



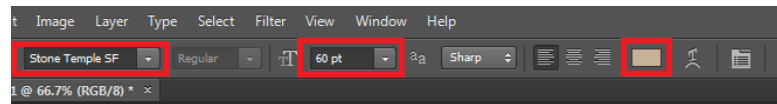
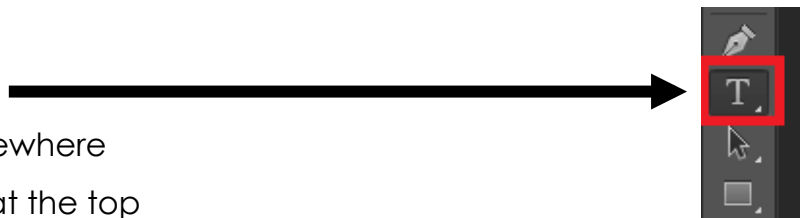
Step 2 - Fill the Background:

1. Find the **Paint Bucket** tool on the left (hold the mouse over the **Gradient** tool, click and hold)
2. Set the colour (use a **Swatch** – top right)
3. Fill the background

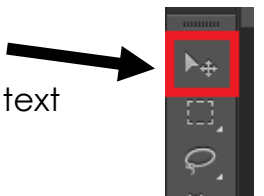


Step 3 - Add Text:

1. Click the **Text** tool on the left
2. **Click once** on the banner somewhere
3. Change the **text size** and **font** at the top
4. Change the **text colour**
5. Type your text > press the **tick** at the top to place the text



- To **move text** use the **Selection tool** at the top of the left toolbar
- To **change text** have the **Text tool** selected and then highlight the text



Step 4 – Adding Images:

1. Click **File > Place**
2. Find the image in your folders and click **Place**
3. Move the file as needed > press the **tick** at top right to place it



Step 5 – Saving your banner:

1. **File > Save As**
2. Choose **PNG** (or JPEG) from the **drop down** > click **OK** if you get a pop up
The **Photoshop** file type will keep the layers but isn't useful on a web page.
