Level 1 (1-3 marks)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Simple diagram with little structure</li> <li>Links not totally logical</li> <li>Content may not be appropriate for the context</li> <li>Little subject specific vocab used</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May lack any subnodes</li> <li>Content does not deal with image collection</li> <li>Max level 1 if an obvious mind map produced but the content is unsuitable</li> </ul>
