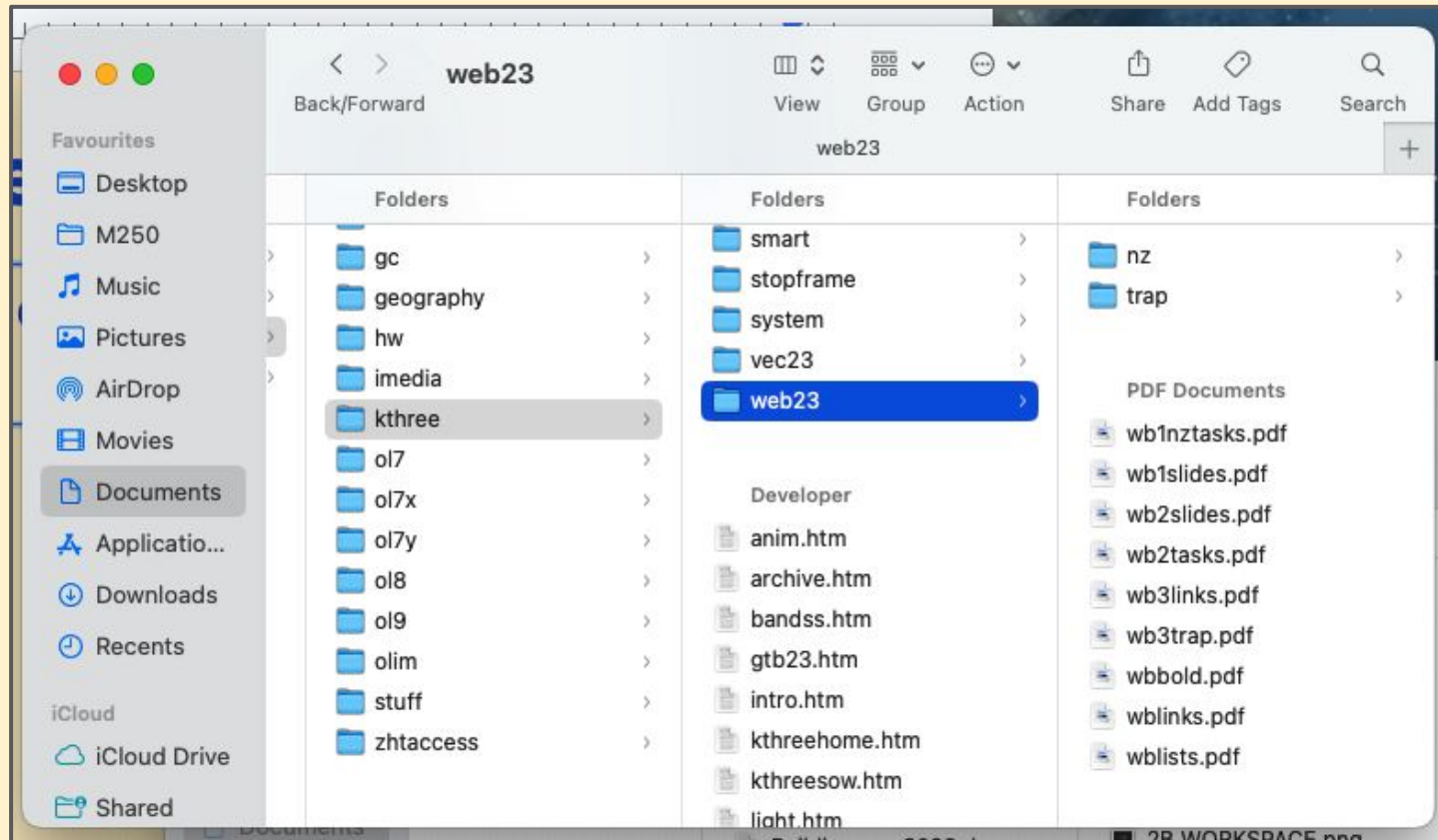
Writing websites in HTML using a text editor is hard work

Key points for today:

1. Setting up the homepage using 1 Header block and 3 Div blocks

3. Saving the homepage as **index.html**
4. Saving the homepage in the **right folder**
5. Moving all the images you might want to use into the **same folder as the homepage**

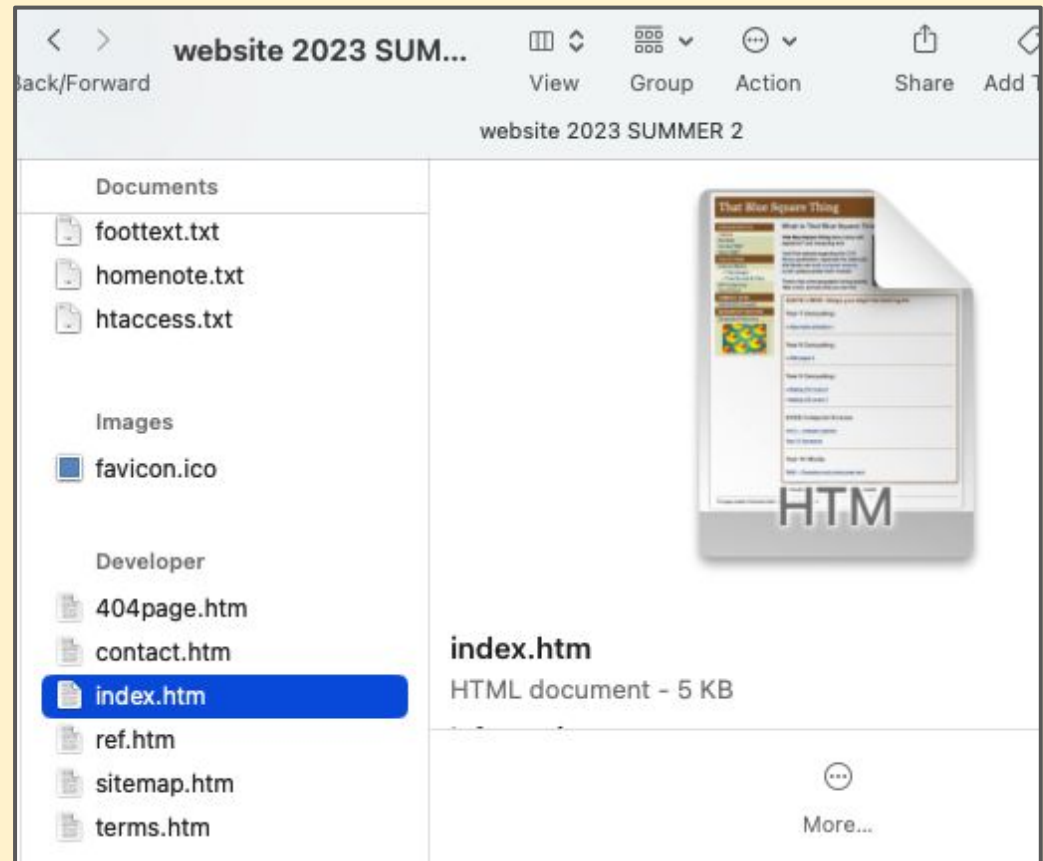
# Using Dreamweaver
